

# HARTMANN-HIRSCHMAN-EGAN AWARD

## *Description*

---

The Hartmann-Hirschman-Egan Award is one of the most coveted awards by the American Concrete Pavement Association. The award recognizes individuals and companies/organizations for excellence in the concrete pavement industry. This award, first presented in 1968, was originally named in honor of Harold W. Hartmann, in 1987, Robert E. Hirschman's name was added, and in 2007, Edward A. Egan's name was added.

All three men demonstrated leadership and tireless dedication to the concrete pavement industry, which helped shape the ACPA and the industry it serves. The award is presented to individuals or groups that demonstrate the same level of dedication as Harold W. Hartmann, Robert E. Hirschman and Edward A. Egan.

## *Eligibility Requirements*

---

All ACPA members, state and federal engineers and government agencies, educators and engineering firms are eligible for nomination. This is a national award and the recipient's contribution must be national in scope. The selection should not be restricted to contributions during the current year. Nominations should be submitted based on one of the following reasons:

### **Representatives of the Concrete Pavement Industry**

- Activities in the promotion of concrete.
- Outstanding record in quality construction projects.
- New and useful innovations for quality concrete paving.
- Dedication to the concrete pavement industry.

### **State and Federal Engineers and Government Agencies**

- Outstanding engineering ability in quality concrete paving construction.
- Development of new ideas, methods, or design for concrete pavements.
- Outstanding job performance in constructing concrete pavements.
- Effective communications with the construction industry.
- Research contributions pertaining to concrete pavements.

### **Educators and Engineering Firms**

- Outstanding engineering contribution to quality concrete pavement construction or design.
- Research contributions in design, methods, or other related aspects of quality concrete pavement construction.

## *Nomination Process*

---

Nominations will be accepted from all ACPA members and Chapter/States in good standing. Only one nomination is allowed per member company or chapter.

## *Selection Process*

---

The ACPA Executive Committee will review the nominations and select the winner.
