

OUTSTANDING GOVERNMENT/PUBLIC OFFICIAL

Description

This award recognizes outstanding contributions by a government or public official for leadership in transportation activities with special emphasis on concrete pavement.

Eligibility Requirements

Government and public officials at any level of government within the United States are eligible.

Nomination Process

Nominations will be accepted from all ACPA members, staff and Chapter/States in good standing. Only one nomination is allowed per member company, staff member or chapter.

Selection Process

The ACPA Executive Committee will review the nominations and select the winner. Each candidate will be judged on the following principles of leadership:

- **Creativity** – The official must have demonstrated creative uses of concrete pavements in solving transportation related problems.
- **Integrity** – The official should have demonstrated history of consistent and sound engineering practices. The official should be honest, open and supportive of industry efforts and ideas.
- **Professionalism** – The official should be active within the transportation field with professional organizations and should contribute to improving the standards of leadership and quality.
- **Service** – Although long-term service and commitment to transportation programs is not in itself a true measure of merit, it is an indication that the official has dedicated their career to the transportation industry. It would also be important to evaluate during their service period, attitudes demonstrating by the use of concrete pavements.
- **Teamwork** – Demonstrated teamwork is an important characteristic of any public official nominated. Involving industry, and ACPA, in the process of systems development and projects is a critical characteristic. Officials who take extra steps to involve ACPA in the entire process are truly the winners to be recognized.
